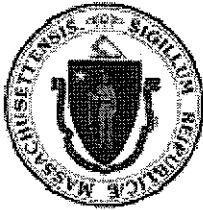

DEFENDANT

On Thursday, June 4, 2026, I, Officer Jordyn Gagliardi of the Chatham Police Department was assigned to take a report of an alleged sexual assault. I was wearing full police uniform, including my body-worn camera.

At approximately 1:07 P.M., I was dispatched to the front lobby to speak with the Reporting Party, _____, and her attorney, Jonathan Schwartz. I led _____ and Mr. Schwartz into the interview room, located directly off the station lobby. They were informed that the interview room was recorded, as well as by my body-worn camera. Detective Sergeant Massey was also in the interview room with us. Mr. Schwartz advised that he can leave the room if requested, as he is here to support his client.

_____ explained that she would like to report "being raped by Braden Peters." _____ advised that she and Mr. Peter started texting on Instagram and it evolved into her being paid to do "Looksmaxxing" videos. Mr. Peters invited her to stream videos online to make her name known on social media. _____ advised that after approximately one week of talking to Mr. Peters, he ordered her an Uber to his residence. Mr. Peters' family's residence is 211 Tisquantum Road in Chatham. Mr. Peters often goes by the names "Clavicular" or "Clav."

_____ stated that Mr. Peters ordered her the Uber from her grandparents' _____, to his family's residence in Chatham. This occurred on Friday, May 23, 2025. _____ is not sure exactly what time she was picked up by the Uber, but believes it may have been at approximately 5:00 P.M. As she arrived at his residence, she greeted Mr. Peters' mother and grandmother inside. _____ is not sure specifically what time she arrived at his residence, but knows that it was nighttime. Mr. Peters led her to a set of stairs near the kitchen and up to his bedroom, where he was streaming live on Twitch. _____ described Mr. Peters' room as having a desk with monitors on top, a bed, a couch, a window overlooking the water, and a dresser on the right side of the bedroom door. She then provided a layout of the residence on a piece of paper, including Mr. Peters' bedroom, as she remembers it. _____ stated that Mr. Peters "was aware of my age," which she confirmed was seventeen at the time. Before entering his bedroom, he instructed her to lie on the live stream to say that she is eighteen years old. He also instructed her to say that the alcohol is water, so that neither his Twitch account nor live stream gets banned.

As the live stream occurred, _____ talked about "Looksmaxxing" and stated that "things were just awkward." _____ advised that she was not aware of any alcohol, only until later in the

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stream when he had it on his desk and offered it to her. She believed that she was just going to receive an Uber back home after the stream ended. I asked her what type of alcohol it was, to which she stated that it was vodka. She stated that she no longer felt the awkward feelings when alcohol was "invited" because she calmed down and was now relaxed. She stated that although they both began consuming the alcohol, she felt that she was peer-pressured to consume it. clarified that before the alcohol was consumed, she was not being touchy or flirty. She stated that she only began to be flirty after the alcohol was consumed, where she and Mr. Peters "kissed once on the stream." I asked how much alcohol she consumed, to which she stated that she likely had "two, three shots, but it was like not really shots, it was more so like cups" and then pointed to a certain level on her coffee cup in front of her. She stated that she was a lightweight, so "at the end, it just got more intense," referring to feeling "drunk" and stronger effects of the alcohol. She stated that "it was a lot, in a way, for me."

stated that Mr. Peters offered her alcohol a second time, which she declined because "it was too much already."

stated that at the end of the stream, it was turned off, and they began to make out on the couch. She stated that she was "really drunk" at this point in time. Despite her stated that she and Mr. Peters go over to his bed and have sex, where he was "throwing me in different positions." stated that she fell asleep in his bed and the next morning, she woke up to Mr. Peters "having sex with me." She stated that because it was already occurring, she did not tell Mr. Peters to stop. advised that she did not consent to the sexual intercourse. She demonstrated how waking up to Mr. Peters "on top" of her was surprising by throwing her hands towards her face and pushing her head backwards. I asked what she remembers feeling in that moment, as Mr. Peters was on top of her, to which she stated that she did not "have a chance to like check my feelings, I was just like was getting fucked when I woke up." She stated, "that was so uncomfortable." I asked if Mr. Peters said anything to her as he was on top, to which she stated that he did not. I asked if she said anything to him as he was on top, to which she stated, "no, I was like in shock." I asked if, at any point, she verbally consented, to which she stated that she did not. She stated that even the night prior, after consuming alcohol, she did not verbally consent either. I asked if she was in fear, to which she stated that she was, as she did not want to talk about what occurred to anyone. She believes it to have been "embarrassing," so she did not want to tell her grandparents, who she lived with at the time.

stated that she did not have any intention on having sex with Mr. Peters either the night

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before or morning after. After Mr. Peters finished having sex with _____, she stated that "he was so cold" and ordered her an Uber home. She did not receive a sexual assault forensic exam afterwards. She stated that after she returned home by the Uber, she had not seen Mr. Peters for approximately six months. I asked _____ who was the first person she told about this incident, to which she stated that she kept it to herself for a while. She eventually told a friend named _____, but she did not have her phone number at the time, due to changing to a new phone, to provide it to me. I advised that once she obtains the phone number, then she can provide it. Later in the investigation, I contacted _____ to obtain the phone number and contact _____ as the First Complaint Witness, but _____ advised that she did not specifically tell _____ or anyone what occurred with Mr. Peters. _____ did not provide me with a phone number for _____ as she stated that she did not inform her of everything that occurred in Chatham with Mr. Peters. She reiterated that she did not tell anyone the full extent of what occurred.

Mr. Schwartz showed clips of the Twitch stream from the incident on his phone. The clips were taken directly from Mr. Peters' Twitch account, which is KingClavicular. In the clips, it shows Mr. Peters and _____ sitting in two chairs. Mr. Peters is shirtless in some of the clips and then wearing a white collared shirt in others. In one clip, Mr. Peters asked _____ "don't you, you get red too when you drink or no?" _____ then asked Mr. Peters if her face appeared red, to which he stated, "a little bit." Both of their cheeks appeared flushed in this clip. In another clip, Mr. Peters was shirtless and _____ stated, "wait I'm so drunk thought" before she and Mr. Peters kissed on the lips.

I asked _____ if she would like to complete a written statement regarding the incident, to which she stated that she would. I provided her with my business card and case number. _____ completed the written statement form in the interview room alone. It has been attached to this case.

Based on _____ level of intoxication, which was brought about by Mr. Peters furnishing alcohol to her for the purpose of engaging in sexual intercourse as she was a minor under the age of 21 years old, I believe that she lacked the ability to consent. For that reason, I believe that probable cause exists to support the following charges against Braden Peters:

- M.G.L. Ch. 265/22/A Rape
- M.G.L. Ch. 265/3 Sexual Intercourse, Drug For
- M.G.L. Ch. 138/3A/C Liquor, Person Under 21 Procure
